**1. HIGH POINT AWARDS – END OF YEAR**

The following system will be used to determine High Point End of Year Awards

6 or more entries in a class, points to be awarded = 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1

5 or more entries in a class, points to be awarded = 5, 4, 3, 2, 1

4 or more entries in a class, points to be awarded = 4, 3, 2, 1

3 or more entries in a class, points to be awarded = 3, 2, 1

2 or more entries in a class, points to be awarded = 2, 1

1 entry in a class, points to be awarded = 1

**2. SHOW POINT ALLOCATION**

The following points will be granted at the shows listed below. **Point earnings for PRAC run shows will attract additional DOUBLE POINTS.**

**National Championship Show = Triple AAA Class Points**

**State Championship Show = Double AA Points**

All horses must be registered with AAA Ltd.

All Owners and Handlers must be members of AAA Ltd.

**'AA' Approved Show = Double Points**

All Royal shows held in Australian Capital Cities, the NPHA and Halter Showcase are deemed to be 'AA' Class shows.

**'A' Pre or Post State Show – Double Points**

**'A' Approved show = Single Points**

**'A' Class Shows – Equestrian Australia (EA) = Single Points**

Official and Associate Dressage days run by affiliates of Equestrian Australia and approved by EA. Show programs must be sent with point recording sheets.

**'B' Show = Single Points**

All recognized Agricultural shows

Annual Horse Shows

AQHA approved shows with no AAA Ltd Approval

Show program must be sent with point recording sheets.

**Supreme Champion Appaloosa**

(All champions compete for this award) 2 points allocated if 3 horses or more in this class.

**Champion Appaloosa Exhibit**

(All first place getters of each class) 2 points allocated if 3 horses or more in the class.

**Champion**

Chosen from first place winners of that gender and age.

**Reserve**

Chosen from second place getter winner to the champion and 1<sup>st</sup> place winners in other classes for that gender.

Where there is a reserve awarded, champion receives 2 points. Where a reserve is not awarded, champion receives 1 point.

**3. ELIGIBILITY & REGULATIONS**

- a) To be eligible for End of Year High Point Awards you must compete at **THREE** approved **Perth Regional Appaloosa Club** run shows. Minimum qualifying point amount of **10 points** will apply.
- b) Points from **PRAC run shows** are automatically recorded by the PRAC Points Collator and forwarded to AAA Ltd on your behalf. Points to be calculated from other clubs must be recorded on an approved Points Recording Sheet by you. Original must be sent to AAA Ltd, copy sent to the PRAC Points Collator and we recommend you keep a copy on file.
- c) Points must be recorded on the approved Points Recording Sheet. (Appendix A) Carbon copy Points Books can be purchased from AAA Ltd.
- d) Competitor show points must be lodged with Perth Regional Appaloosa Club Points Collator within **60 days of the show and by 31 July of each point year**. After this time result point sheets will be invalid.
- e) Points will not be accepted unless the points recording sheets are correctly completed, signed and readable.
- f) For A Class Equestrian Australia, and B Class shows, a copy of the show program must accompany show results sheets.
- g) The Show Secretary or show Manager must delete the excess lines on the points recording sheets before signing. Exhibitors are to request this if this has not been done.
- h) Youth Events: show points for Youth Events must be clearly marked 'YOUTH EVENTS JUNIOR /SENIOR' and recorded on a separate sheet. Maximum of two horses per Youth.
- i) Amateur events must be clearly marked 'Amateur' and recorded on a separate sheet. Maximum of two horses per Amateur.
- j) Show point scores will not be given to anyone other than the owner or properly authorized person.

- k) Any Other Registered Breed or Best Presented classes at breed shows are non point scoring classes. To gain points in HALTER, the classes have to be designated Appaloosa classes.
- l) WA Bred and EASTERN STATES BRED classes within PRAC have strict rules. WA Bred is where a registered Appaloosa Stallion resides in Western Australia at the time of mating. Eastern States Bred is where a registered Appaloosa Stallion resides outside of Western Australia at the time of mating.
- m) The above rule applies to OPEN WA and OPEN EASTERN STATES BRED classes, which are open to other breeds, Appaloosas sired by registered Appaloosa stallions gain points.
